Archer, Jeffrey **Tell Tale** - In this collection of short stories, Archer gifts us with a dozen different tales ranging from murder mysteries to romance to war stories based on real events that have critics comparing him to Dumas, Dahl, and Maugham.

Brown, Dan **Origin** (Robert Langdon, book 5) - Harvard symbologist Robert Langdon is thrust into the dangerous intersection of humankind's two most enduring questions, and the earthshaking discovery that will answer them.

Connelly, Michael **Two Kinds of Truth** – Mystery - (Harry Bosch, book 22) - Harry Bosch is back as a volunteer working cold cases for the San Fernando Police Department and is called out to a local drug store where a young pharmacist has been murdered. Bosch and the town's three person detective squad sift through the clues, which lead into the dangerous, big business world of pill mills and prescription drug abuse.

Feehan, Christine **Leopard's Blood** – Romance - (Leopard People, Book 10) – Book 10 of Feehan's Leopard People Series brings us Joshua Tregre's and the woman who lures him into revealing his true self.

Graham, Heather **Shadows in the Night** - Romance - (Finnegan Connection, book 2) – FBI agent Micah Fox is used to charging into dangerous territory to solve a case. Working with a civilian is new ground, especially when she's as irresistible as Harley. He can't say no to her sharp instincts and sexy smile. And with a threat closing in, there's no way in hell he'll leave her unprotected.

Grisham, John **The Rooster Bar** – Three friends who all borrowed heavily to attend a law school so mediocre that its graduates rarely pass the bar exam, learn that their school is one of a chain owned by a shady New York hedge-fund operator who also happens to own a bank specializing in student loans, the three know they have been caught up in the Great Law School Scam.

Hilderbrand, Elin **Winter Solstice** (Winter, book 4) - It's been too long since the entire Quinn family has been able to celebrate the holidays under the same roof, but that's about to change. They are preparing for a holiday more joyous than any they've experienced in years, but it just wouldn't be a Quinn family gathering if things went smoothly.

Hill, Joe **Strange Weather** - A collection of four chilling novels, ingeniously wrought gems of terror from the brilliantly imaginative, number one New York Times best-selling author of *The Fireman*; Joe Hill.

James, Eloisa **Wilde in Love** - Romance - (Wildes of Lindow Moss, book 1) - Lord Alaric Wilde is revered for his dangerous adventures and rakish good looks. Arriving home from years abroad, he has no idea of his own celebrity until his boat is met by mobs of screaming ladies. Alaric escapes to his father's castle, but just as he grasps that he's not only famous but notorious, he encounters the very private, very witty, Miss Willa Ffynche.

Johansen, Iris **Mind Game** – Mystery - (Eve Duncan, book 22) - A down on his luck Hollywood director's actress wife is taken over by a Scientology like mind game cult called Transformationism. She disappears into the bowels of Transformationism. He's determined to rescue her, to the point where he pretends to be taken over too. Is he or isn't he?

Jones, Darynda **The Trouble with Twelfth Grave** – Science Fiction - (Charley Davidson, book 12) – Charley Davidson, Grim Reaper, is back in this 12th novel of Darynda Jones's bestselling paranormal series.

Kellerman, Faye **Killing Season** - Mystery - an electrifying crime novel of suspense as a young man's obsessive investigation into his sister's death draws him into the path of a sadistic serial killer.

Macomber, Debbie **Merry and Bright** – Romance - It's been a long year for Merry, so, her mother and brother make her an online dating profile. Intrigued, she starts chatting with a charming stranger, and their exchanges soon become the brightest part of her day. But everything turns upside down when they finally meet in person.

Palmer, Diana **Wyoming Winter** - Romance - (Wyoming Men, book 7) – Cultivating his vast Wyoming ranch is all security expert J. C. Calhoun wants. Sandford, John ***Deep Freeze*** –Mystery - (Virgil Flowers, book 10) - Virgil knows the town of Tripton, Minnesota, a little too well. A few years back, he investigated the corrupt, and, homicidal, local school board. Now there is more alarming news. A woman's been found dead, and it might be connected to a high school class of twenty years ago that has a mid-winter reunion coming up.

Steel, Danielle ***Fairytale*** –Romance- Camille has grown up surrounded by her family's vineyards. Her parents have built a renowned winery and château. Camille has had a perfect childhood, and after graduating from Stanford, she returns to help manage Château Joy, but her fairytale ends suddenly with her mother's death from cancer.

Woods, Sherryl ***Lilac Lane*** - Romance - (Chesapeake Shores, book 14) - Lilac Lane is a brand-new story in her beloved Chesapeake Shores series, one readers all over the world have waited two years to read!

Woods, Stuart ***Quick and Dirty*** –Mystery - (Stone Barrington, book 43) - Stone Barrington is the master of keeping calm and collected under fire, but his latest case will challenge even his tireless aplomb.

Baldacci, David ***End Game*** (Will Robie, book 5) - Lethal government assassin Will Robie returns in David Baldacci's number one New York Times best-selling series!

Bradford, Barbara Taylor ***Secrets of Cavendon*** - It's the summer of 1949, and a new generation is at the helm of Cavendon Hall. With romance, betrayal, heartbreak, and possible murder threatening to tear them apart, the Inghams and Swanns will have to find a way to come together and protect each other in the face of threats they never could have predicted.

Child, Lee ***The Midnight Line*** (Jack Reacher, book 22) – A woman's West Point class ring in a pawn shop window causes Reacher to wonder what circumstance made her give up something she earned over four hard years. He decides to find out. And find the woman. And return her ring. Why not?

Clancy, Tom and Marc Cameron ***Tom Clancy Power and Empire*** - An aggressive challenge from the Chinese government, and a routine traffic stop in rural Texas leads to a shocking discovery; a link to a Chinese spy who may have intelligence that lays bare an unexpected revelation. John Clark is in close pursuit, but can they get the information in time?

Clark, Mary Higgins and Alafair Burke ***Every Breath You Take*** –Mystery - (Under Suspicion, book 5) - The "Queen of Suspense" is back! Every Breath You Take follows television producer's Laurie Moran investigation of the unsolved Met Gala murder-in which a wealthy widow was pushed to her death from the famous museum's rooftop.

Coonts, Stephen ***The Armageddon File*** –Mystery (Book 8 Grafton & Carmellini) After a hard fought election, the new president's chief of staff discovers evidence that voting machines were tampered with and the whole administration is in danger of unraveling. Grafton and Carmellini race to solve the mystery of a potentially stolen election before Americans' faith in democracy, sovereignty, and federal government become completely undone.

Cedar Hawk is four months pregnant, and has to go back to her own biological beginnings as the society around her begins to disintegrate, fueled by a swelling panic about the end of humanity.

Evanovich, Janet ***Hardcore Twenty-Four*** –Mystery- (Stephanie Plum, book 24) - This Jersey girl hits hard twenty-four seven. The blockbuster Stephanie Plum series continues with this from number one New York Times best-selling author Janet Evanovich.

Evans, Richard Paul ***The Noel Diary*** - Just two weeks after his wife leaves him Jason learns that his estranged mother has passed away days before Christmas. Curiosity about his past and anxiety about his future fuel him, and maybe cleaning out her house will be slightly less depressing than spending the holidays, alone, watching re-runs of Christmas classics.

Frost, Jeaniene ***Brightest Embers*** -Romance- Ivy thought that she and Adrian had conquered their fates. Yet with thousands of innocents still trapped in the demon realms, she's determined to locate the final hallowed weapon and harness its unparalleled power to free them. The last relic nearly put Ivy in the grave, there's probably no coming back from this one.

James, P.D. ***Sleep No More*** - Six short stories by P. D. James where she shows her expert control of the short-story form, conjuring motives and scenarios with complete conviction, and each with a satisfying twist in the tail.

Kingsbury, Karen ***In This Moment*** -Inspirational-Hamilton High Principal Wendell Quinn is tired of the violence, drug abuse, teen pregnancies, and low expectations at his school. A single father of four, Quinn is a Christian and a family man who wants to see change in his community, so he starts a voluntary after-school Bible Study. He knows he is risking his job by leading the program, but the high turnout at every meeting encourages him.

Koontz, Dean ***The Neighbor*** -The year is 1967. Malcolm Pomerantz is twelve, geeky, and socially awkward, while his seriously bright sister, Amalia, is spirited and beautiful. Each is the other's best friend, united by a boundless interest in the world beyond their dysfunctional parents' unhappy home. But even the troubled Pomerantz household will seem to be a haven compared to the house next door, after an enigmatic and very secretive new neighbor takes up residence in the darkest hours of the night.

Krentz, Jayne Ann ***I Promise Not To Tell*** - Following the book *When All the Girls Have Gone*; this will have a cameo appearance by Max, but the main character will be his brother, Cabot Sutter. They have different last names because they are only foster brothers. The mystery will involve the real possibility of the cult re-emerging on-line.

McCall Smith, Alexander ***The House of Unexpected Sisters*** -Mystery-Mma Ramotswe and Mma Makutsi are approached by Mr. Polopetsi, with a troubling story of a woman who, has been wrongly dismissed from her job at an office furniture store for being rude to a customer. Mma Ramotswe begins to investigate and soon discovers unexpected information that causes her to reluctantly change her views about the case.

Murray, Graham ***American Drifter*** - A young veteran of the US Army, River Roulet is struggling to shake the horrors of his past. War is behind him, but the memories remain. Desperate to distract himself from the images haunting him daily, River abandons the world he knows and flees to the country he's always dreamed of visiting: Brazil.

Patterson, James ***The People vs. Alex Cross*** - When Alex's former partner Sampson shows up needing his help, Cross jumps at the chance to prove himself, even if it may end up costing him what's left of his career. A string of young, blonde women have gone missing and the investigation leads to the most depraved, darkest corners of the internet.

Patterson, James and Ashwin Sanghi ***Count to Ten*** - Santosh Wagh quit his job as head of Private India after harrowing events in Mumbai almost got him killed. But Jack Morgan, global head of the world's finest investigation agency, needs him back. Jack is setting up a new office in Delhi, and Santosh is the only person he can trust. Plastic barrels containing dissolved human remains have been found in the basement of a house in an upmarket area of South Delhi. But this isn't just any house; this property belongs to the state government. With the crime scene in lockdown and information suppressed by the authorities, delving too deep could make Santosh a target to be eliminated.

Patterson, James and James O Born ***Manhunt*** - Someone attacked the Thanksgiving Day Parade directly in front of Michael Bennett and his family. The television news called it 'holiday terror'; Michael Bennett calls it personal. The hunt is on.

Sanderson, Brandon ***Oathbringer*** - Return to a planet swept by apocalyptic storms, a world tipping into war as aristocratic families move to control the shard blades and shard plate, ancient artifacts from a past civilization that can win wars in the third installment in Brandon Sanderson's Stormlight Archive series.

Steel, Danielle ***Past Perfect*** - From number one New York Times best-selling author Danielle Steel, this is a spellbinding story of two families living a hundred years apart, who come together in time in a startling moment, opening the doors to rare friendship and major events in early twentieth century history.

Weir, Andy ***Artemis*** - Everything changes when Jazz sees the chance to commit the perfect crime, with a reward too lucrative to turn down. But pulling off the impossible is just the start of her problems, as she learns that she's stepped square into a conspiracy for control of Artemis itself. And that now her only chance at survival lies in a gambit even riskier than the first.

Arden, Katherine ***The Girl in the Tower*** (Bear and Nightingale Series Book 2) - For a young woman in medieval Russia, the choices are stark: marriage or a life in a convent. Vasya will choose a third way: magic...

Chiaverini, Jennifer ***Enchantress of Numbers*** - New York Times bestselling author Jennifer Chiaverini illuminates the fascinating life of Ada Byron King, Countess of Lovelace—Lord Byron's daughter, the world's first computer programmer, and a woman whose exceptional contributions to science and technology have been too long unsung.

Corey, James S. A. ***Persepolis Rising*** (Expanse Book 7) – Science Fiction - The seventh novel in James S. A. Corey's New York Times bestselling Expanse series--now a major television series.

Crais, Robert ***The Wanted*** - Devon Connor hires private investigator Elvis Cole, it's because her troubled teenage son Tyson is flashing cash and she's afraid he's dealing drugs. But the truth is devastatingly different. With two other partners in crime, he's been responsible for a string of high-end burglaries, a crime spree that takes a deadly turn when one of them is murdered and Tyson and his girlfriend disappear. They stole the wrong thing from the wrong man. Determined to get it back, he has hired a team that is smart and brutal, and to even the odds, Cole calls in his friends Joe Pike and Jon Stone. But even they may be overmatched. The hired killers are leaving a trail of bodies in their wake. A few more won't make any difference.

Fowler, Christopher ***Wild Chamber*** (Book 14 in the Bryant & May Series) - The members of London's Peculiar Crimes Unit are on the case again when a dog walker is found dead. The method of the death is odd...the killer had no way in - or out - and the dog is nowhere to be seen. But the 'hows' and 'whys' of the murder are not the only mysteries, and it seems very likely that the killer is preparing to strike again.

Griffin, W.E.B. & William E. Butterworth IV ***Death at Nuremberg*** - When Jim Cronley hears he's just won the Legion of Merit, he figures there's another shoe to drop, and it's a big one: he's out as Chief, DCI-Europe. His new assignments, however, couldn't be bigger: to protect the U.S. chief prosecutor in the Nuremberg trials from a rumored Soviet NKGB kidnapping, and to hunt down and dismantle the infamous Odessa, an organization dedicated to helping Nazi war criminals escape to South America. It doesn't take long for the first attempt on his life, and then the second. NKGB or Odessa? Who can tell? The deeper he pushes, the more secrets tumble out:. Which one will turn out to be the most dangerous? Cronley wishes he knew

Higgins, Kristan ***Now That You Mention It*** - New York Times bestselling author Kristan Higgins welcomes you home in a funny, emotionally charged must-read novel about the complications of life, love and family

McDermid, Val ***Insidious Intent*** (10th Book in the Hill & Jordan Series) - In *Insidious Intent*, Tony and Carol are on the hunt for a serial killer who victimizes women at weddings without a date - and forces the duo to confront their most haunting moral dilemma so far.

Page, Katherine Hall ***The Body in the Casket: a Faith Fairchild Mystery*** (Faith Fairchild book 24) -Faith has been hired to cater legendary Broadway producer/director Max Dane's 70th birthday party, but her real task is to figure out why someone has sent him a coffin containing a 20-year-old Playbill from his final production, his only flop. Max is convinced that someone wants him dead.

Roberts, Nora ***Year One*** - It began on New Year's Eve. The sickness came on suddenly, and spread quickly. The fear spread even faster. Within weeks, everything people counted on began to fail them. The electrical grid sputtered; law and government collapsed, and more than half of the world's population was decimated. Where there had been order, there was now chaos. And as the power of science and technology receded, magic rose up in its place. Some of it is good, like the witchcraft worked by Lana Bingham, practicing in the loft apartment she shares with her lover, Max. Some of it is unimaginably evil, and it can lurk anywhere, around a corner, in fetid tunnels beneath the river, or in the ones a person knows and loves the most. As word spreads that neither the immune nor the gifted are safe from the authorities who patrol the ravaged streets, and with nothing left to count on but each other, Lana and Max make their way out of a wrecked New York City.

Rollin, James ***The Demon Crown*** (book 13 Sigma Force) - Sigma Force must solve a mystery going back eons, to when life first took root on this planet. But the menace is spreading, changing, growing, adapting, and outwitting every attempt to stop it. It means to retake a world it once ruled. For Sigma Force to stop it, Commander Grayson Pierce will have to do the unthinkable: team up with Sigma's greatest enemy-the newly resurrected Guild--even if it means sacrificing one of their own.
